Composer Interviews

Since 2023, we have interviewed **62 composers** (38 men, 24 women) through **podcasts and YouTube**, with 38% women, offering stronger representation than is typical in classical music programming.

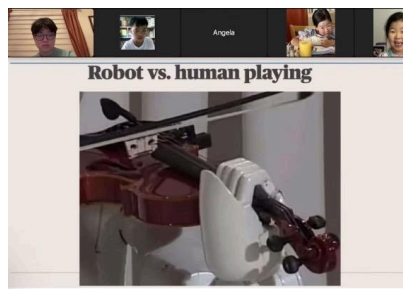

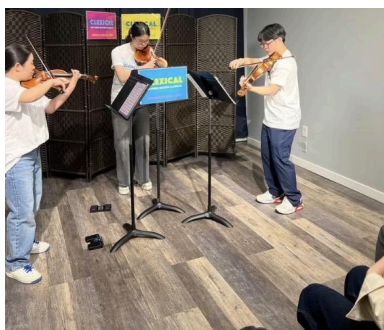
